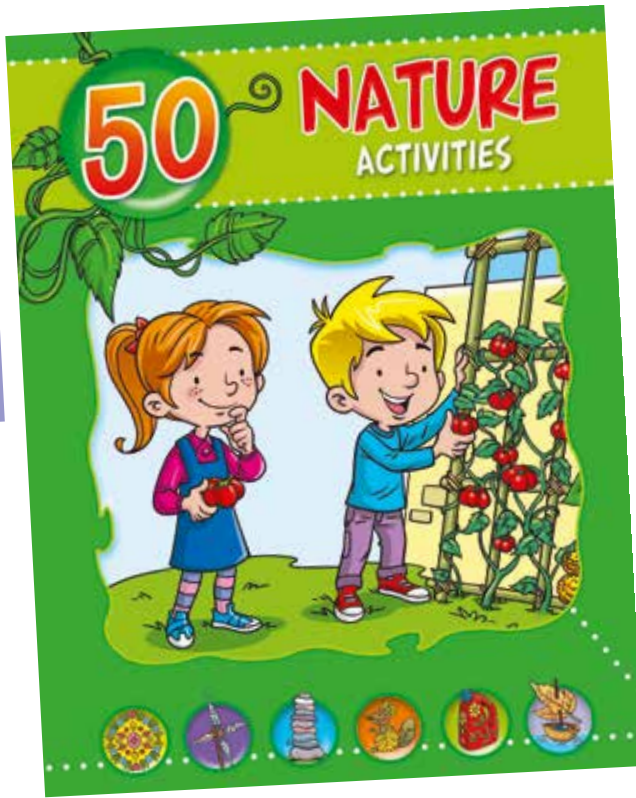

MINI-ALLOTMENT

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1 packet of seed (about 20 long and 20 short)
- A trowel
- A wheelbarrow
- Earthworms
- Compost (about 200 g)
- A trowel or garden fork
- A watering can

DO YOU KNOW?

If you have a trowel or garden fork, you should use it to dig the soil up to 10 cm deep. If you don't, you can use your hands to dig the soil up to 10 cm deep.

HOW TO DO IT

1. Dig a hole in the soil about 10 cm deep.
2. Put a handful of earthworms in the hole.
3. Add a handful of compost to the hole.
4. Mix the soil and compost with your hands.
5. Fill the hole with soil and water.
6. Now you can start to grow!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A string
- A hole in a piece of wood
- A string

HOW TO DO IT

1. Hold one end of the string and the other end of the string in a hole in the wood.
2. Use the string to hold the string in a hole in the wood.
3. Repeat with the other end of the string.
4. Hang the string in a hole in the wood.
5. Hang your photo in a hole in the string.

ALTERNATIVE

You can use a hole in a piece of wood to hold a string in a hole in the wood.
