“Woof, woof!”



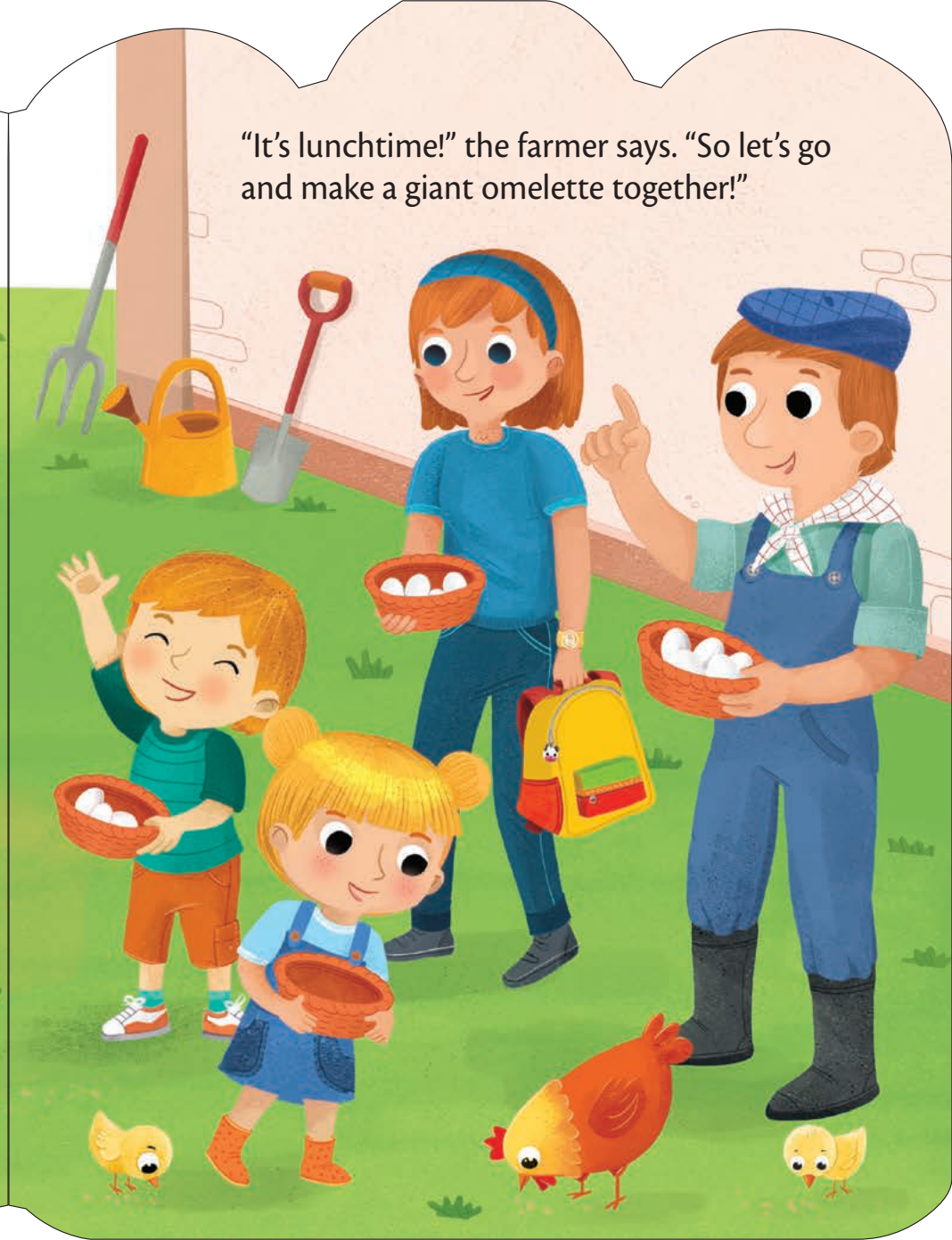
Next, they go over to the rabbit hutch.
