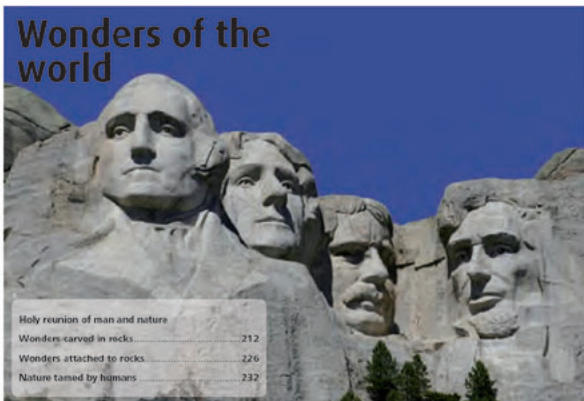

In China in 1574, the boring of a well in a remote village revealed one of the most stupendous achievements made by man: Qin Shi Huang's grave. He was the first Chinese emperor during the 3rd century BC who unified China and had the idea of building the Great Wall of China.



In 1900, the grave had 6,000 terracotta warriors and their horses and all enlaid. Their faces and clothes were brightly painted but the colours did not withstand the test of time.

In the USA, the heads of the 4 most outstanding presidents have been carved at an altitude of 1,745 m into a granite cliff: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln. It is called the **Mount Rushmore National Memorial** located in South Dakota. The heads are 58m high and were sculpted between 1927 and 1941. Projects to add John F. Kennedy, Ronald Reagan and even Elvis Presley's faces have been considered!



The **Crater** **Herse** **Memorial** is located in the black hills of South Dakota, a group of the latter the yellow had a diameter of 11 m high. Started in 1909, the carving of the face worked on his horse and passed by. They should become the world's largest sculpture when completed.
