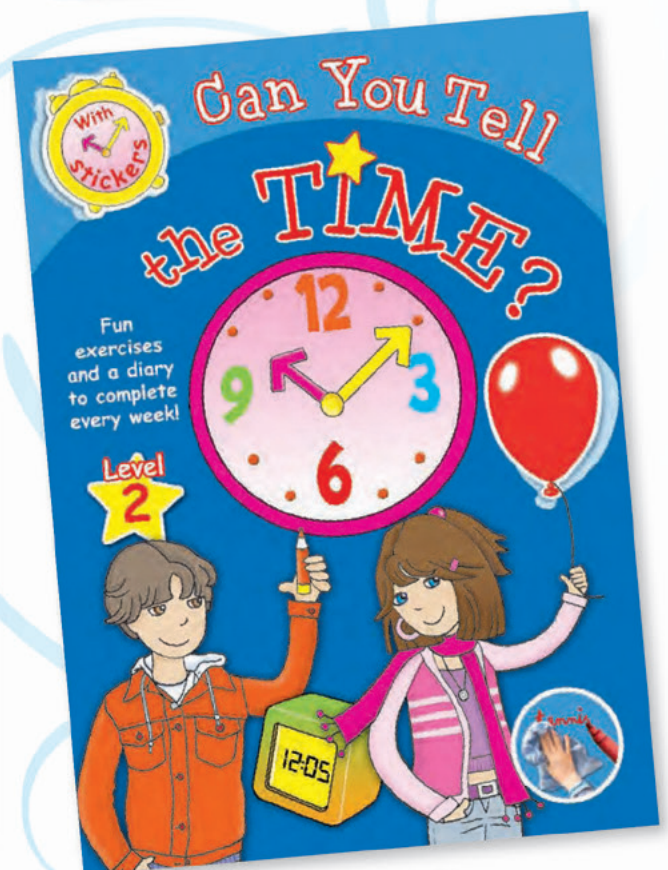

A quarter of an hour is, as it says, the quarter of one hour, that is 15 minutes.

A quarter past...

Do you know?
When it is a quarter past, the big hand stands on number 3.

Give each child his corresponding watch.

Julian's watch indicates a quarter past five.

Zoe's watch indicates a quarter past one.

On Lisa's watch, it is a quarter past nine.

Circle the clocks that indicate a quarter past the hour.

Circle that it is 11:15 am, trace the missing hand on each clock.

Circle the correct clock.

At a quarter past eleven, Tim is still riding his bike.

It is a quarter past four and Emily is playing on the swing.



Two titles with two difficulty levels for this series that will help children to learn and slowly assimilate the very abstract concept of time. The gentle progression in difficulty, the stickers and the central wipe-clean spread will progressively teach the kids how to read hours, half hours, quarters of an hour and finally minutes. They will have hours of fun drawing the time on the wipe-clean clocks: analogue clock for easy level; analogue and digital clocks for more advanced children! Last but not least on the **wipe-clean** pages, they will also have the opportunity to organise their time by completing the weekly diary and start again week after week.
